

The mission of “Ecoles de la 2e Chance” is to fight school dropout amongst young people and to help them get a diploma to be reintegrated into society. The “Ecole de la 2e Chance” of Marseille is the 1st school of its kind created in Europe. Since its creation (1997), dozens of similar structures opened up throughout Europe. Its objectives is to ensure, through education and training, the professional and social integration of young drop-outs for more than 1 year, without diploma or qualification (age 18 - 25).



The issue

Extend their activities to other regions, guaranteeing

- The validation and accreditation of trainees' skills through online training of basic sets of skills,
- The quality in guidance and monitoring to meet similar standards as in traditional training,
- The reduction of operating costs per trainee, in order to be able to assist a larger number of trainees.

The solution

- MOS Chorus, a **blended platform** forming part of a defined school organisational model :
 - Face-to-face or online monitoring of a trainee or a group of trainees (powerful dashboards)
 - Implemented workflows where trainees, teachers and pedagogical managers are in the heart of the system
- A pool of content for the entire network and a training program administration, decentralised in each school.

Results: 400 trainers trained on the EDA platform monitoring, 10'000 trainees (that either were trained or went through some modules), 71 user entities, 70 training courses, 800 indexed documents.
